

PETERBOROUGH CITY ROWING CLUB COACHING COURSE BURSARY

Peterborough City Rowing Club is committed to supporting individuals in attaining recognised qualifications.

There are a number of grants available within the Eastern Region which will supplement the cost of certain courses and PCRC is committed to supporting individuals in gaining access to this funding. PCRC will apply for this funding on your behalf and in the event that a candidate is unsuccessful in achieving external funding, PCRC will fund up to 50% of the cost of a recognised course.

Any funding will only contribute towards the cost of the course itself. The cost of attaining prerequisites for a course, transport, refreshments, equipment and any other additional costs will need to be covered by the applicant.

Who can apply?

In order to be eligible for funding each candidate must meet the following criteria at their own expense:

- Be a member of Peterborough City Rowing Club
- Be a member of British Rowing
- Meet the minimum age for coaching (18+ for a Level 2)
- Are currently coaching in a voluntary capacity at PCRC
- Identify and book the course you wish to attend.
- Are committed to attending and completing a coaching course and providing evidence to PCRC for the completion of your qualification.
- Are able to pay the remaining cost of the course.
- Be committed to continuing to coach in a voluntary capacity at PCRC for a period of 12 months upon completion of the course.

Process

The following process is applicable to all candidates undertaking a course who wish to apply for funding:

- The candidate must identify and book onto a suitable course at their own expense this includes completing the associated requirements for the course which can include First Aid, Capsize and Man Overboard workshop, Safety Basics Risk Assessment On-line Module, Cold Water & Hypothermia on-line Module, Safeguarding and Protecting Children, and the practical assessments.
- 2. The candidate should apply for funding by completing the PCRC Coaching Course Bursary Application Form.
- 3. If successful, an agreement between PCRC and the candidate is assumed which shows a commitment between PCRC and the candidate. PCRC will be committed to providing support to the candidate whilst the candidate must commit to providing a set number of voluntary coaching hours at PCRC for a period of 12 months (this will be determined when the agreement is signed).

The candidate will not be reimbursed until the qualification (including assessment) has been achieved, the certificate issued and a further period of six months of voluntary coaching has been completed at PCRC. This period of coaching will be monitored by the Chair of the Rowing Committee and Coaching Co-ordinator.

Deadline dates

The Bursary Panel will meet monthly and grants cannot be awarded retrospectively. Therefore we ask that applicants submit their bursary application before attending the course for which the funding is being sought.
