IMPORTANT NOTES

1. Doubling up is at own risk. Competitors may not race in more than two events each day and boats may not be used in more than 2 events per day.
2. At the discretion of the Regatta Committee an entry limit of 350 per day may have to be imposed. If entry limits are exceeded entries may be closed earlier and preference will be given to entries paid for at the time of the draw.
3. Race details will be emailed to your club Online Entry account address so you must ensure that this is up to date.
4. Competitors and those responsible for them should be aware that photographers will be operating at the regatta.

Racing will be under the new British Rowing Competition Framework using the personal ranking index system.

Senior events will be split into bands of competitors/crews using ranking indices at the discretion of the Regatta Committee. For Masters events racing will be based on age categories and the handicap system will be used where appropriate to create events, at the discretion of the Regatta Committee.
