IMPORTANT NOTES

- 1 Doubling up is at own risk. Competitors may not race in more than two events each day and boats may not be used in more than 2 events per day.
- 2 At the discretion of the Regatta Committee an entry limit of 350 per day may have to be imposed and entries in any one event may have to be limited to 16. If entry limits are exceeded entries may be closed earlier and preference will be given to entries paid for at the time of the draw.
- 3 Masters events will be based on age categories but ranking indices & handicap system may be used at the discretion of the Regatta Committee
- 4 Race details will be emailed to your club Online Entry account address so you must ensure that this is up to date.
- 5* All winners identification shall be confirmed. Winners who cannot confirm their identity shall not receive any crew or individual prize until their eligibility has been confirmed in 7-2-3
