\*Due to the lack of competition over the last year, for all events on Sunday, we are using metrics in addition to BROE's crew ranking index. For each entry, you must submit a predicted 1,000m time, which may be used to create bandings for large events. The time trials will be 4-lane racing from a stakeboat start. The fastest crews across all time trials will be seeded into respective ABCD finals, with up to the slowest 2 crews being eliminated. We believe this will provide crews with the best possible side-by-side racing.

#### **Important Notes**

- 1. All entries to be submitted through BROE. Entries will close on **Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> May at 22:00** but may be suspended earlier if oversubscribed
- 2. The Draw will take place on **Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> May** and will be released by 22:00 Monday 31<sup>st</sup> May
- 3. Doubling up between Divisions is permitted, but NOT within a Division
- 4. Entry Fee: £15 per head (excluding coxes) payable via BROE ONLY
- 5. Masters events will be handicapped in accordance with BR's Rules of Racing
- 6. Pewter tankards will be awarded for all Final-A winners
- 7. No refreshments will be available, make sure you bring plenty of food and drink
- 8. Competitors will be asked to leave the site as soon as their racing is finished
- 9. All support staff (coaches/caregivers/trailer drivers) attending must complete the Contact Form <a href="https://forms.gle/iWAqp7cEwJduyx798">https://forms.gle/iWAqp7cEwJduyx798</a>. You will not be allowed on site unless this has been completed.

### **Primary Conditions of Entry** (further Competitor Instructions & Conditions will be posted at a later date)

- Competitors, coaches & caregivers agree to abide by all Government & British Rowing Covid-19 Guidance in
  place at the time of the competition including social distancing, hygiene & will have actively carried out a
  self-assessment health check prior to attending. If anyone shows signs of COVID-19 before the event they
  should not attend. If someone develops symptoms on the day, they and their household/crew/group
  members should leave immediately and inform the COVID-19 Officer via phone.
- 2. Each entering club must give a single point of contact to act as their Covid-19 Liaison. This person must be present whilst your crews are on site and will act as the conduit for the dissemination of any Covid-19 related information
- 3. Spectators must be strongly discouraged from attending by their own club. Clubs may be asked to leave the Competition & entries withdrawn without refund if it is found that supporters are on site as a result of the regatta. Caregivers of juniors are permitted.
- 4. All attendees should follow the 'self-sufficiency' guidance as set out in British Rowing's Managing Covid-19 guidance.
- 5. Competitors & support staff/caregivers will be expected to base themselves in their own vehicles when not preparing to race, racing, or de-boating. You should not gather in crowd forming groups.
- 6. Competitors & support staff/caregivers will be expected to wear face coverings at all times when moving around the site, these may be removed once seated in a boat.
- 7. Should the regatta need to be cancelled either before or during the competition on the grounds of safety or instruction from statutory authorities with regard to Covid-19, the regatta will endeavor to make a partial refund of entry fees once accurate costs have been calculated.
