4-lane time trials seeding 4-lane ABCD finals

All events will be from a stakeboat start. There will be 4-lane side-by-side time trials, whereby the fastest times across all races in an event will be seeded into ABCD finals as per the matrix below.

| 9-12 crews | From 3xTTs | To 2xFinals [A/B] (remainder eliminated) |
| 13-16 crews | From 4xTTs | To 3xFinals [A/B/C] (remainder eliminated) |
| 17-18 crews | From 5xTTs | To 3xFinals [A/B/C] (remainder eliminated) |
| 19-20 crews | From 5xTTs | To 4xFinals [A/B/C/D] (remainder eliminated) |
| 21-24 crews | From 6xTTs | To 4xFinals [A/B/C/D] (remainder eliminated) |

Entries exceeding 24 crews will be split into two randomly assigned groups, with medals awarded to the winner of FinalA in each group.

Important Notes

- 1. All entries to be submitted through BROE.
- 2. Entries close at **22:00 on Saturday 17th June** unless closed earlier due to oversubscription.
- 3. Entries in any one event may have to be limited at the discretion of the organising committee if there is a very high level of demand.
- The draw will take place on Sunday 18th June and will be released by 22:00 on Monday 19th June.
- 5. Entry Fee: £16 per head (excluding coxes) payable via BROE ONLY.
- 6. Medals will be awarded for 1^{st} , 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} positions in all "A" Finals.
- 7. Additional prizes will be awarded to the individuals showcasing the "Best Cox" and "Best Watermanship" skills.
- 8. The Victor Ludorum Shield will be awarded to the most successful club.
- 9. Food, drinks, cake and general refreshments will be available to purchase. Please bring your own refillable mugs if possible.
- 10. Should the regatta need to be cancelled either before or during the competition on the grounds of safety or instruction from statutory authorities, the regatta will endeavour to make a partial refund of entry fees once accurate costs have been calculated.
- 11. Competitor Instructions will be published together with the draw.
