All racing will take place via 4-lane time trials, which will seed crews into respective ABCD finals. Depending on entry size, the slowest crews from the time trial may be eliminated. Banding based on CRI may be used for large events.

21-24 crews	From 6xTTs	To 4xFinals [A/B/C/D] (<i>remainder eliminated</i>)

Important Notes

1. All entries to be submitted through BROE.
2. Entries close at **22:00 on Saturday 27th May** but may be suspended earlier if oversubscribed.
3. The Draw will take place on Sunday 28th May and will be released by **22:00 on Monday 29th May**.
4. Entry Fee: £16 per head (excluding coxes) payable via BROE ONLY.
5. Doubling up between Divisions is permitted, but NOT within a Division.
6. Where applicable, Masters events will be handicapped in accordance with BR's rules of racing.
7. Pewter tankards for all Final-A winners.
8. All events will be from a stakeboat start.
9. The Victor Ludorum Shield will be awarded to the most successful club over the 2 days.
