4-lane time trials seeding 4-lane ABCD finals

All events will be from a stakeboat start. There will be 4-lane side-by-side time trials, whereby the fastest times across all races in an event will be seeded into ABCD finals as per the matrix below.

1-4 crews	N/A	Final A
5-8 crews	From 2xTTs	To 1xFinal [A] (remainder eliminated)
9-12 crews	From 3xTTs	To 2xFinals [A/B] (remainder eliminated)
13-16 crews	From 4xTTs	To 3xFinals [A/B/C] (remainder eliminated)
17-18 crews	From 5xTTs	To 3xFinals [A/B/C] (remainder eliminated)
19-20 crews	From 5xTTs	To 4xFinals [A/B/C/D] (remainder eliminated)
21-24 crews	From 6xTTs	To 4xFinals [A/B/C/D] (remainder eliminated)

No more than 3 crews in a given event from any one club/school [3].

Entries exceeding 24 crews will be split into two randomly assigned groups, with medals awarded to the winner of Final A in each group.

Important Notes

- 1. All entries to be submitted through BROE.
- 2. Entries close at **22:00 on Saturday 21st June** unless closed earlier due to oversubscription.
- 3. Due to capacity limitations and in the interest of fairness, clubs/schools should submit **no more than three crews** in a given event. Any more than this will be rejected.
- 4. Entries in any one event may have to be limited at the discretion of the organising committee if there is a very high level of demand, a waiting list will be setup accordingly.
- 5. The draw will take place on Sunday 22nd June and will be released by **22:00 on Monday 23**rd.
- 6. Entry Fee: £17 per head (excluding coxes) payable via BROE ONLY.
- 7. Doubling up between Divisions is permitted, but NOT within a Division.
- 8. All events will be from a stakeboat start.
- 9. Medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd positions in all "A" Finals.
- 10. Additional prizes will be awarded to the individuals showcasing the "Best Cox" and "Best Watermanship" skills.
- 11. The Victor Ludorum Shield will be awarded to the most successful school/club.
- 12. Food, drinks, cake and general refreshments will be available to purchase. Please bring your own refillable mugs if possible.
- 13. Competitor Instructions will be published together with the draw.
